Along with the application, the applicant should include the following supporting documentation:

- A current (including 2022 Fall semester information) transcript showing high school credits earned, dual enrollment credits, GPA, and ACT/SAT scores.
- An acceptance letter from Mott Community college showing you are enrolled in for 2023-2024.
- An Activities resume detailing the school and community activities in which you participate, specifically noting any leadership positions held.
- An essay titled "What it Means to be a LEADER" explaining why leadership is important, leadership roles held and how you plan to continue to be a LEADER in the future (not to exceed 500 words).
- Two letters of recommendation-one letter must be from a school employee and the other from a community member.
